2019 Gavi di Gavi Rovereto, Michele Chiarlo

£26 (2018)

100% Cortese. Aromas of ripe apples, spice, anise and dried grass give onto a fresh, steely dry, full palate.

2020 Gavi dei Gavi, La Scolca

£73

100% Cortese. On the nose intense fruity and flowery notes. Almonds and hazelnut on the palate. Medium to full bodied, with a very long and rich finish.

2018 Rossj Bass, Gaja

£145

100% Chardonnay. Fine perfume of citrus fruits and flowers, with a hint of honey. Very elegant body, definite character and good acidity; a fresh, lingering finish.

2018 Gaja & Rey

£325

100% Chardonnay. Angelo Gaja's flagship, fresh but complex nose with citrus tones. On the palate it is intense but with elegance and minerality followed by a long finish

Veneto – Trentino Alto Adige

2020 Pinot Grigio, Santa Margherita

£43

£23 (2018)

100% Pinot Grigio. This is a dry white wine with an appealing flavour of Golden Delicious apples.

2018 Gewürztraminer, St Michael- Eppan

£45

Intense floral scent and sweet-spice, aromatic richness and strength. Fine spices, cloves and the gentle fragrance of roses characterise. The wine is an ideal accompaniment to fish dishes, especially crustaceans, lobster and crab.

2019 Sauvignon, St Michael Eppan

£49

100% Sauvignon. Dry and mineral white wine; with aromas of dry apple, peach and fresh citrus.

Friuli Venezia Giulia

2018 Pinot Bianco – Opimio

£52

100% Pinot Bianco. Straw yellow with light green veins. Manifest aromas of citrus, apple, kiwi, melon, almond flowers and candy. soft approach and savory.

2017 Vintage Tunina - Jermann Friuli

£105

A blend of Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Ribolla Gialla, Malvasia Istriana, Picolit. It is crisp, dry, medium-bodied white wine with marvellously complex flavours

2019 Conte Della Vipera, Antinori

£59

80% Sauvignon Blanc, 20% Semillon. Notes of citrus fruit along with white peaches and lychees. Vibrant vein of acidity which adds freshness to the flavours.

2017 Cervaro Della Sala, Antinori

90% Chardonnay, 10% Grechetto. Fresh bouquet of hazelnut butter, vanilla and white flowers. It is elegant on the palate and extremely savoury, crisp, and vibrant.

2020 Verdicchio, Dei Castelli di Jesi Classico, Moncaro

£37

100% Verdicchio. This is a dry enjoyable white wine with intrinsic almond and citrus flavours.

Campania

2018 Ripa Bianca, Galluccio Bianco Telaro

£41

100% Falanghina can have a slight pine scent, but is better known for its citrus-blossom aromas, in particular bitter orange. On the palate it typically shows classic apple and pear flavours

2020 Greco di Tufo, Feudi di San Gregorio

£47

100% Greco. Vibrant wine with classic pear and green plum fruit. Full bodied on the palate with a lively acidity and peachy minerality, very typical of the region.

Sicily

2019 Alta Mora, Etna Bianco

£44

100% Carricante. Bright yellow with deep aromas of ripe apple, white flowers, lemon icing and ginger. Spicy and rich, finishes long with nuances of minty herbs at the back

2019 Sancerre, Domaine Gérard Millet

£48

100% Sauvignon Blanc. Gold colour with green tints. Floral and fruity aromas. Lively and supple on the palate.

2019 Pouilly Fumé, Château de Tracy

£54

100% Sauvignon Blanc. Pale gold with silver highlights, bright. It is a fresh, well-balanced dry white with a flinty bouquet; blackcurrant leaf and concentrated mineral flavours.

Burgundy

2018 Chablis, Domaine Grand Roche (½)

£27

100% Chardonnay. Dry, clean, a touch of green in the gold colour and a good weight of fruit on the palate.

2019 Chablis, Domaine Jean Gouley & Fils - Organic

£55

100% Chardonnay. Yellow appearance with green sheens. Open nose with exotic fruits' notes. In the mouth, nice sharp attack marked by the light minerality. Persistence with almond's notes.

2018 Pouilly Fuissé, Nadine Ferrand

£58

100% Chardonnay. Pouilly Fuissé wines owe their reputation to the high limestone content of the soil. It is well balanced and full of flavour.

2018 Chablis 1er Cru, Domaine Jean Gouley & Fils

£78

100% Chardonnay. Soft, ripe fruit on the palate with a crisp finish. A distinguished wine with a fine Chardonnay buttery taste.

2017 Meursault-Charmes 1er Cru, Domaine René Monnier

£110

100% Chardonnay. Beautiful integration of oak with rich, elegantly styled fruit and a balanced acidity through to a wonderful long, butterscotch well sustained finish.

2017 Puligny Montrachet 1er Cru, Les Folatières

£120

100% Chardonnay. Elegant and generous with apricot and mineral notes on the nose and palate.

2017 Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru, Domaine Marc Morey & Fils

£125

100% Chardonnay, full body, structured, nose of very fine ripe fruit, long in the mouth, ample, long guard. A wine that leads both minerality and power by relying on a beautiful tension.

2018 Barbera d'Alba Cordero di Montezemelo

100% Barbera. Intense violet colour. Mature fruit, cacao, prune, spicy, fragrant nose. Full and fresh mouth. Very soft tannins.

2015 Barolo, Bersano

£49 (50cl)

100% Nebbiolo grapes. Fresh wild strawberries. Dusty with iron and mint on the nose. Powerful, with a long, rounded finish.

2016 Barolo, Michele Chiarlo

£75

100% Nebbiolo. Very solid and rich centre palate with dried berry and chocolate character and hints of hazelnuts. Full and velvety.

2015 Barolo, Pio Cesare

£113

100% Nebbiolo grapes. An earthy Barolo with savoury flavours and spicy/herbal finish. Well made with lovely flavours both delicate and intense.

2016 Barolo Dagromis, Gaja

£123

£64

100% Nebbiolo, rich and dense in palate, nuanced with liquorice and herb notes.

2009 Gaja, Sori San Lorenzo

£600

100% Nebbiolo. Deep red in colour, with aromas of currant and black cherry fruit and a hint of coffee, with a long, lingering finish and refined tannins.

Veneto – Trentino Alto Adige

2017 Pinot Nero Riserva, St Michael Eppan

£49

Bright red. The slow fermentation in small oak barrels maximizes the features making it diverse, complex, and distinctly fruity with a nice hint of vanilla.

2015 Amarone Della Valpolicella Classico Costasera, Masi

£80

£50 (2013)

40% Corvina, 30% Corvinone, 30% Rondinella. Intense garnet red in colour. Aromas of ripe blueberries, blackberries and cherries. The palate is rich, full bodied and complex.

2011 Amarone Della Valpolicella Classico, Vaio Armaron, Serego Alghieri

£115

Blend of Corvinia, Rondinella and Molinara Grapes. Rich fruit flavours. Its elegant personality is enhanced by ageing in cherry-wood casks.

2018 Chianti Classico, Castello di Albola 100% Sangiovese. Ruby-red in color (advancing to garnet), bursting with notes of strawberry, red berries, sage, spice cake and subtle earth on the nose. It is vibrant and medium bodied, revealing lively cherry and exotic spice and leading to polished tannins and a delicate finish.	£43	£24 (2016)
2017 Chianti Classico Riserva, Villa Antinori 90% Sangiovese, 10% Cabernet. Ruby red colour, the nose shows notes of red berry fruit. The flavours are balanced, with light and tonic acidity and silky and vibrant tannins.	£49	
2017 Vino Nobile Montepulciano, Boscarelli 70% Sangiovese 30% Canaiolo. Intense aromas of red fruit and sweet spices.	£56	£28
2019 Il Bruciato, Antinori 65% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot, 15% Syrah. Intense aromas of red berries with note of sweet spices well balanced.	£57	
2018 Rosso di Montalcino, Donatella Cinelli Colombini 100% Sangiovese. Hints of small red fruits which lingers at length. The palate is intense, harmonious, reasonably warm and suitably tannic.	£58	
2016 Brunello di Montalcino Caparzo 100% Sangiovese. Dark ruby-red. Full, round and silky, with lots of aromas of blackberry and plum. Full bodied elegance with fine tannins.	£88	£45
2015 Brunello di Montalcino, Pieve Santa Restituta, Gaja 100% Sangiovese Grosso. Deep ruby red. With cherry notes, forest fruits, aromatic herbs and juniper aromas. On the palate ripe tannins, integrated acidity, rich structure and lingering finish.	£130	
2015 Lamaione, Frescobaldi 100% Merlot Grapes. Ruby red, the aroma is distinct of matured fruits, rich and lingering and on the palate, it is coarse and harmonic.	£130	
2014 Guado Al Tasso Blend of cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. Intense aromatic and silky tannins with note of dark fruits and liquorice	£200	
2017 Tignanello, Antinori Sangiovese 80% Cabernet Sauvignon 15%, Cabernet Franc 5% The wine has a plum-cassis smoky nose, is full-bodied, rich and complex, with exceptional structure and lengthy finish.	£195	
2012 Brunello di Montalcino, Biondi Santi 100% Sangiovese. It opens with aromas of forest floor and dried rose petals. The palate showcases concentrated wild cherry and cinnamon-spice flavours alongside bracing tannins.	£275	
2011 Ornellaia, Tenuta dell Ornellaia, Bolgheri Blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc & Petit Verdot. Silky-texture with big ripe but dry tannins.	£380	
2017 Solaia, Antinori 75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Sangiovese. The wine is elegant with nicely blended tannins. Hints of liquorice and coffee return in the impressively long finish.	£520	
2013 Sassicaia, Tenuta San Guido 85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Cabernet Franc. Sassicaia is intensely fruity, finely structured and complex. It has spicy tones, almost smoky nose, and intense taste, long and elegant.	£640

2017 Montepulciano, Colle Secco, Cantina Tollo

£45

100% Montepulciano. Ripe red fruit, violets and spicy notes of liquorice, clove and cocoa. Full bodied with sweet and velvety tannins.

Puglia

2017 Primitivo di Manduria, 62 Anniversario Riserva, San Marzano

£52

100% Primitivo. Notes of plum, spices, with character and great structure.

Sardinia

2016 Turriga, Isola del Nuraghi, Argiolas

£98

Blend of Cannonau, Malvasia Nera, Carignano and Bovale Sardo. Great character with powerful tannins and notes of liquorice.

Sicily

2017 Alta Mora, Etna Rosso

£44

100% Nerello Mascalese. Ruby red in colour, this wine has spicy pepper aromas with notes of blackcurrant and mountain herbs. The texture is vibrant and with soft, supple tannins.

Burgundy – Rhône Valley

2016 Châteauneuf du Pape, Les Cailloux

£75

70% Grenache, 17% Mourvèdre, 10% Syrah, 3% Cinsault. Silky and perfumy, with bergamot, red currant, warm raspberry coulis and rooibos tea notes all woven together. A chalky, mineral spine frames the finish, revealing a lingering star anise accent.

2014 Gevrey Chambertin 1er Cru, Vieilles Vignes, Les Fontenys

£155

100% Pinot Noir. Round and ripe and rich with an interesting salinity. Lifted fruit, quite mineral, pure very dry and long.

2015 Côte Rôtie ‘Ampodium’ Dom. Rene Rostaing

£140

100% Syrah. full red. Has a charming, open and forthcoming nose with a basket of red fruits and attractive sweetness: raspberry liqueur, there are fine tannins towards the finish

Bordeaux

2014 Château Batailley, Grand Cru Classé, Pauillac

£115

70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc. This is a solid muscular dense plum colour wine, earthy cassis aromas as well as flavours. Medium to full bodied, tannic and fresh with a crisp profile.

2016 Château Prieuré Lichine, Grand Cru Classé, Margaux

£145

Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot Fresh, silky, ripe, round and with layers of black cherry, liquorice, blackberry, espresso and floral notes, the wine is concentrated, lively and polished.

2019 Pinot Grigio Blush, Sentito

£36

100% Pinot Grigio, a fine and delicate aroma of rare elegance, pleasantly supported by fruity and flavour notes.

2018 La Scolca, Rosachiara

£45

95% Cortese, 5% Pinot Noir. Harmonious on the palate, a bouquet of strawberry and other mixed berries.

2019 Sancerre Rosé, Domaine Tabordet

£48

100% Pinot Noir with notes of wild strawberry and hints of cherry on the nose, this wine shows brambly fruits on the palate, a smooth texture and a refreshing finish.

2020 Whispering Angel, Chateau d'Esclans, Côtes de Provence

£70

The blend consists of Grenache, Cinsault, Rolle (Vermentino), Syrah and Tibouren. Petal aromas, Soft summer fruit flavours, crisp, clean, fresh and elegant.

The grapes come from the most select land in the surrounding region of La Motte in Provence.
