100% Chardonnay. Fine perfume of citrus fruits and flowers, with a hint of honey. Very elegant body, definite character and good acidity; a fresh, lingering finish.

2019 Gaja & Rey

100% Chardonnay. Angelo Gaja's flagship, fresh but complex nose with citrus tones. On the palate it is intense but with elegance and minerality followed by a long finish

2021 Pinot Grigio, Santa Margherita

100% Pinot Grigio. This is a dry white wine with an appealing flavour of Golden Delicious apples.

2020 Gewürztraminer, St Michael- Eppan

£49

Intense floral scent and sweet-spice, aromatic richness and strength. Fine spices, cloves and the gentle fragrance of roses characterise. The wine is an ideal accompaniment to fish dishes, especially crustaceans, lobster and crab.

2021 Sauvignon, St Michael Eppan

£53

100% Sauvignon. Dry and mineral white wine; with aromas of dry apple, peach and fresh citrus.

2021 Chardonnay, St Michael Eppan

£51

100% Chardonnay. Bright yellow with glints of green. Fruity aromas of ripe apple, melon and banana. Fresh, juicy and persistent on the palate

100% Pinot Bianco. Straw yellow with light green veins. Manifest aromas of citrus, apple, kiwi, melon, almond flowers and candy. soft approach and savory.

80% Sauvignon Blanc, 20% Semillon. Notes of citrus fruit along with white peaches and lychees. Vibrant vein of acidity which adds freshness to the flavours.

2020 Cervaro Della Sala, Antinori

90% Chardonnay, 10% Grechetto. Fresh bouquet of hazelnut butter, vanilla and white flowers. It is elegant on the palate and extremely savoury, crisp, and vibrant.

100% Verdicchio. This is a dry enjoyable white wine with intrinsic almond and citrus flavours.

2018 Ripa Bianca, Galluccio Bianco Telaro

£39

100% Falanghina can have a slight pine scent, but is better known for its citrus-blossom aromas, in particular bitter orange. On the palate it typically shows classic apple and pear flavours

2020 Greco di Tufo, Feudi di San Gregorio

£49

100% Greco. Vibrant wine with classic pear and green plum fruit. Full bodied on the palate with a lively acidity and peachy minerality, very typical of the region.

2020 Alta Mora, Etna Bianco

£46

100% Carricante. Bright yellow with deep aromas of ripe apple, white flowers, lemon icing and ginger. Spicy and rich, finishes long with nuances of minty herbs at the back

2021 Vermentino di Sardegna Manzanille, Gabbas

100% Vermentino. An elegant nose; floral, citrus notes and almond. Smooth and well rounded with zesty acidity and lovely minerality. A nice long finish with a lingering taste almond.

100% Sauvignon Blanc. Pale gold with silver highlights, bright. It is a fresh, well-balanced dry white with a flinty bouquet; blackcurrant leaf and concentrated mineral flavours.

2019 Pouilly Fuissé, Nadine Ferrand

100% Chardonnay. Pouilly Fuissé wines owe their reputation to the high limestone content of the soil. It is well balanced and full of flavour.

100% Chardonnay. Expressive and full floral aromas precede a delightful flavoured and intense dry wine where mineral characteristics abound.

100% Barbera. Intense violet colour. Mature fruit, cacao, prune, spicy, fragrant nose. Full and fresh mouth. Very soft tannins.

2015 Barolo, Bersano

100% Nebbiolo grapes. Fresh wild strawberries. Dusty with iron and mint on the nose. Powerful, with a long, rounded finish.

2017 Barolo, Michele Chiarlo

100% Nebbiolo. Very solid and rich centre palate with dried berry and chocolate character and hints of hazelnuts. Full and velvety.

2018 Barbaresco Pora, Ca' del Baio

100% Nebbiolo grapes. Intense and complex on the nose with fruity overtones conjuring up plums and blackberries, spicy hints of vanilla and roasted hazelnuts. Full bodied yet soft and velvety tannins.

100% Nebbiolo, rich and dense in palate, nuanced with liquorice and herb notes.

100% Nebbiolo. Deep red in colour, with aromas of currant and black cherry fruit and a hint of coffee, with a long, lingering finish and refined tannins.

Bright red. The slow fermentation in small oak barrels maximizes the features making it diverse, complex, and distinctly fruity with a nice hint of vanilla.

£53 (2016)

40% Corvina, 30% Corvinone, 30% Rondinella. Intense garnet red in colour. Aromas of ripe blueberries, blackberries and cherries. The palate is rich, full bodied and complex.

2013 Amarone Della Valpolicella Classico, Vaio Armaron, Serego Alghieri

Blend of Corvinia, Rondinella and Molinara Grapes. Rich fruit flavours. Its elegant personality is enhanced by ageing in cherry-wood casks.

100% Sangiovese. Ruby-red in color (advancing to garnet), bursting with notes of strawberry, red berries, sage, spice cake and subtle earth on the nose. It is vibrant and medium bodied, revealing lively cherry and exotic spice and leading to polished tannins and a delicate finish.

2018 Chianti Classico Riserva, Villa Antinori

90% Sangiovese, 10% Cabernet. Ruby red colour, the nose shows notes of red berry fruit. The flavours are balanced, with light and tonic acidity and silky and vibrant tannins.

100% Sangiovese. Hints of small red fruits which lingers at length. The palate is intense, harmonious, reasonably warm and suitably tannic.

100% Sangiovese. Dark ruby-red. Full, round and silky, with lots of aromas of blackberry and plum. Full bodied elegance with fine tannins.

100% Sangiovese Grosso. Deep ruby red. With cherry notes, forest fruits, aromatic herbs and juniper aromas. On the palate ripe tannins, integrated acidity, rich structure and lingering finish.

Sangiovese 80% Cabernet Sauvignon 15%, Cabernet Franc 5% The wine has a plum-cassis smoky nose, is full-bodied, rich and complex, with exceptional structure and lengthy finish.

Blend of cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. Intense aromatic and silky tannins with note of dark fruits and liquorice

Cabernet Franc, Cabernet Sauvignon. A rich, dense nose with distinctive red fruits and a hint of perfume. A ripe and elegant palate has an understated concentration and a firm, long finish.

2006 Brunello di Montalcino, Biondi Santi

100% Sangiovese. It opens with aromas of forest floor and dried rose petals. The palate showcases concentrated wild cherry and cinnamon-spice flavours alongside bracing tannins.

2017 Ornellaia, Tenuta dell Ornellaia, Bolgheri

Blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc & Petit Verdot. Silky-texture with big ripe but dry tannins.

2014 Solaia, Antinori

75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Sangiovese. The wine is elegant with nicely blended tannins. Hints of liquorice and coffee return in the impressively long finish.

2017 Sassicaia, Tenuta San Guido

£640

85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Cabernet Franc. Sassicaia is intensely fruity, finely structured and complex. It has spicy tones, almost smoky nose, and intense taste, long and elegant.

2009 Masseto

An impressively dark hue, Masseto 2009 mirrors its vintage, exhibiting intense impressions of ripe cherry, chocolate, spice, and coffee. Profound and full-bodied in the mouth, it boasts explosive fruit, and tannins which are glossy and firm.

100% Montepulciano. Ripe red fruit, violets and spicy notes of liquorice, clove and cocoa. Full bodied with sweet and velvety tannins.

2018 Primitivo di Manduria, 62 Anniversario Riserva, San Marzano

100% Primitivo. Notes of plum, spices, with character and great structure.

Sardinia

2017 Turriga, Isola del Nuraghi, Argiolas

£105

Blend of Cannonau, Malvasia Nera, Carignano and Bovale Sardo. Great character with powerful tannins and notes of liquorice.

100% Nerello Mascalese. Ruby red in colour, this wine has spicy pepper aromas with notes of blackcurrant and mountain herbs. The texture is vibrant and with soft, supple tannins.

2019 Châteauneuf du Pape, Les Cailloux

70% Grenache, 17% Mourvèdre, 10% Syrah, 3% Cinsault. Silky and perfumy, with bergamot, red currant, warm raspberry coulis and rooibos tea notes all woven together. A chalky, mineral spine frames the finish, revealing a lingering star anise accent.

2018 Gevrey Chambertin 1er Cru “Les Corbeaux”, Dom. Lucien Boillot

100% Pinot Noir. The nose is perfumed with cherry and redcurrant, with a powerful palate full of both red and black fruit flavours. Well-structured with fine tannins and ripe, silky fruit lingering on the finish.

2015 Côte Rôtie ‘Ampodium’ Dom. Rene Rostaing

100% Syrah. full red. Has a charming, open and forthcoming nose with a basket of red fruits and attractive sweetness: raspberry liqueur, there are fine tannins towards the finish

70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc. This is a solid muscular dense plum colour wine, earthy cassis aromas as well as flavours. Medium to full bodied, tannic and fresh with a crisp profile.

2016 Château Prieuré Lichine, Grand Cru Classé, Margaux

Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot Fresh, silky, ripe, round and with layers of black cherry, liquorice, blackberry, espresso and floral notes, the wine is concentrated, lively and polished.

2020 Sancerre Rosé, Domaine Tabordet

100% Pinot Noir with notes of wild strawberry and hints of cherry on the nose, this wine shows brambly fruits on the palate, a smooth texture and a refreshing finish.
