100% Cortese. Delicate aroma of ripe peach and pear on the nose with hints of pineapple and lychees. On the palate it offers full aroma of lime and tropical fruits a long and creamy almond finish. Medium acidity.

#### **2022 Gavi dei Gavi, La Scolca**

£91

100% Cortese. On the nose intense fruity and flowery notes. Almonds and hazelnut on the palate. Medium to full bodied, with a very long and rich finish.

#### **2021 Rossj Bass, Gaja**

£151

100% Chardonnay. Fine perfume of citrus fruits and flowers, with a hint of honey. Very elegant body, definite character and good acidity; a fresh, lingering finish.

#### **2020 Gaja & Rey**

£375

100% Chardonnay. Angelo Gaja's flagship, fresh but complex nose with citrus tones. On the palate it is intense but with elegance and minerality followed by a long finish.

### *Veneto - Trentino Alto Adige*

#### **2021 Soave Classico DOC 'Vigneto Colombara'**

30% Chardonnay, 70% Garganega. Soave 'Vigneto Colombara' has a straw yellow colour with emerald highlights. Intense yet delicate bouquet, wonderfully crisp and clean.

#### **2021 Gewürztraminer, St Michael- Eppan**

Intense floral scent and sweet-spice, aromatic richness and strength. Fine spices, cloves and the gentle fragrance of roses. An ideal accompaniment to fish dishes, especially crustaceans, lobster and crab.

#### **2021 Sauvignon, St Michael Eppan**

100% Sauvignon. Dry and mineral white wine with aromas of dry apple, peach and fresh citrus.

#### **2021 Chardonnay, St Michael Eppan**

£51

100% Chardonnay. Bright yellow with glints of green. Fruity aromas of ripe apple, melon and banana. Fresh, juicy and persistent on the palate.

### *Friuli Venezia-Giulia*

**2021 Pinot Grigio Lamis Grave Friuli 2021 Giralan** £47  
100% Pinot Grigio. A light, sappy nose with a distinctive almond tone. On the palate it is rounded and with a lively crispness on the finish.

**2021 Pinot Bianco, Jermann** £77  
It has a golden, brilliant straw-yellow colour. Its aroma is intense, very persistent and pleasantly fruity with a distinct hint of melon. Its taste is dry, velvety, well-orchestrated and very persistent.

**2020 Afix Riesling, Jermann** £85  
Partly vinified on the skins, it has a brilliant straw-yellow colour with light greenish highlights. Its aroma is very intense and persistent, lightly aromatic, pleasantly fruity. Its taste is crisp, fresh, and very well balanced due to its soft texture and lively vigour.

### *Umbria*

**2022 Torre di Giano, Bianco di Torgiano D.O.C.** £45  
A fresh white wine, straw-coloured with greenish reflections, fruity with long-lasting, intense bouquet that recalls citrus fruit, white blossoms and fresh fruit salad; dry and with good structure

**2021 Cervaro Della Sala, Antinori** £162  
90% Chardonnay, 10% Grechetto. Fresh bouquet of hazelnut butter, vanilla and white flowers. It is elegant on the palate and extremely savoury, crisp, and vibrant.

### *Tuscany*

**2021 Vernaccia di San Gimignano, Vigna Santa Margherita, Panizzi** £69  
A broad and inviting nose of white fruits, peach and apricot, alongside nettles and white flowers. The palate is round and rich with sweet yellow fruit, melon, tertiary notes, crushed flint stone, and subtle oak influence.

### *Campania*

**2021 Greco di Tufo, Feudi di San Gregorio** £57  
100% Greco. Vibrant wine with classic pear and green plum fruit. Full bodied on the palate with a lively acidity and peachy minerality, very typical of the region.

### *Sicily*

**2020 Alta Mora, Etna Bianco** £51  
100% Carricante. Bright yellow with deep aromas of ripe apple, white flowers, lemon icing and ginger. Spicy and rich, finishes long with nuances of minty herbs at the back.

### *Sardegna*

**2021 Vermentino di Sardegna Manzanille, Gabbas** £52  
100% Vermentino. An elegant nose; floral, citrus notes and almond. Smooth and well-rounded with zesty acidity and lovely minerality. A nice long finish with a lingering taste of almond.

Gold colour with green tints. Floral and fruity aromas. Lively and supple on the palate.

A pale, brilliant gold with golden highlights. A complex olfactory expression dominated by very ripe fruit and the minerality from the limestone pebbles. Breathing reveals the floral notes of white flowers, followed by citrus fruit but also white fruit

**2019 Pouilly Fumé Baron de L**

This dry white displays a classic smokey, lime and mineral influenced flavour reflective of the region's flinty soils. Delivering an elegant and well balanced taste of kiwi fruit and gooseberries it then leaps into a fresh and clean tang with a delicious zesty lime finish

100% Chardonnay. Pouilly Fuissé wines owe their reputation to the high limestone content of the soil. It is well balanced and full of flavour.

100% Chardonnay. Expressive and full floral aromas precede a delightful flavoured and intense dry wine where mineral characteristics abound.
