2022 Riesling Langhe DOC, Ca' del Baio

£58

100% Riesling, straw yellow colour with greenish reflections; intense and aromatic bouquet with fruity notes of pineapple and mango and slight nuances of hydrocarbon.

The taste is dry, delicate, elegant, characterized by a good acid/alcohol balance.

2023 Gavi di Gavi D.O.C.G. La Smilla

£61

100% Cortese. Delicate aroma of ripe peach and pear on the nose with hints of pineapple and lychees. On the palate it offers full aroma of lime and tropical fruits a long and creamy almond finish. Medium acidity.

2023 Gavi dei Gavi D.O.C.G. La Scolca

£97

100% Cortese. On the nose intense fruity and flowery notes. Almonds and hazelnut on the palate. Medium to full bodied, with a very long and rich finish.

2022 Rossj Bass, Gaja

£165

100% Chardonnay. Fine perfume of citrus fruits and flowers, with a hint of honey. Very elegant body, definite character and good acidity; a fresh, lingering finish.

2020 Gaja & Rey

£380

100% Chardonnay. Angelo Gaja's flagship, fresh but complex nose with citrus tones. On the palate it is intense but with elegance and minerality followed by a long finish.

2022 Lugana, Selva Capuzza

£59

100% Turbiana di Lugana. With aromas of magnolia, lemon verbena, Fuji apple and wild herbs. The crisp and electric palate pops with mixed citrus notes, tart nectarine, thyme and salted almonds, finishing with a stony minerality.

Veneto - Trentino Alto Adige

2022 Soave Classico D.O.C. 'Vigneto Colombara'

£43

30% Chardonnay, 70% Garganega. Has a straw yellow colour with emerald highlights. Intense yet delicate bouquet, wonderfully crisp and clean.

2022 Gewürztraminer, St Michael- Eppan

£58

Intense floral scent and sweet-spice, aromatic richness, & strength. Fine spices, cloves & the gentle fragrance of roses. An ideal accompaniment to fish dishes, especially crustaceans, lobster & crab.

2022 Sauvignon, St Michael Eppan

£56

100% Sauvignon. Dry and mineral white wine with aromas of dry apple, peach & fresh citrus.

2022 Chardonnay, St Michael Eppan

£54

100% Chardonnay. Bright yellow with glints of green. Fruity aromas of ripe apple, melon and banana. Fresh, juicy and persistent on the palate.

Friuli Venezia-Giulia

2022 Pinot Grigio Lamis Grave Friuli Grlan £47
100% Pinot Grigio. A light, sappy nose with a distinctive almond tone. On the palate it is rounded and with a lively crispness on the finish.

2022 Pinot Bianco, Jermann £84
It has a golden, brilliant straw-yellow colour. Its aroma is intense, very persistent and pleasantly fruity with a distinct hint of melon. Its taste is dry, velvety, well-orchestrated and very persistent.

Umbria

2022 Torre di Giano, Bianco di Torgiano D.O.C. £45
A fresh white wine, straw-coloured with greenish reflections, fruity with long-lasting, intense bouquet that recalls citrus fruit, white blossoms and fresh fruit salad; dry and with good structure

2021 Cervaro Della Sala, Antinori £185
90% Chardonnay, 10% Grechetto. Fresh bouquet of hazelnut butter, vanilla and white flowers. It is elegant on the palate and extremely savoury, crisp, and vibrant.

Tuscany

2022 Vernaccia di San Gimignano, Vigna Santa Margherita, Panizzi £69
A broad and inviting nose of white fruits, peach and apricot, alongside nettles and white flowers. The palate is round and rich with sweet yellow fruit, melon, tertiary notes, crushed flint stone, and subtle oak influence.

2020 Casadei Le Anfore Ansonaco £70
100% Ansonica. The wine has seen skin contact for 100 days and is vinified and aged in terracotta amphorae for 4 to 6 months. Typical of the orange style, the palate has some light phenolic structure as well as notes of white peach and plum. The tannins are supported by excellent freshness and acidity which combined with a persistent herbal character leaves an impressive finish.

Campania

2021 Greco di Tufo, D.O.C.G Terrantica, I Favati £61
100% Greco. A full, ripe flavoured wine on the nose and on the palate it displays a certain richness and a well-balanced elegance.

Sicily

2022 Alta Mora, Etna Bianco £56
100% Carricante. Bright yellow with deep aromas of ripe apple, white flowers, lemon icing and ginger. Spicy and rich, finishes long with nuances of minty herbs at the back.

Sardegna

2023 Vermentino di Sardegna Manzanille, Gabbas £55
100% Vermentino. An elegant nose; floral, citrus notes and almond. Smooth and well-rounded with zesty acidity and lovely minerality. A nice long finish with a lingering taste of almond.

2022 Sancerre, Domaine Merlin Cherrier

£72

Gold colour with green tints. Floral and fruity aromas. Lively and supple on the palate.

2019 Pouilly Fumé de Ladoucette

£98

A pale, brilliant gold with golden highlights. A complex olfactory expression dominated by very ripe fruit and the minerality from the limestone pebbles. Breathing reveals the floral notes of white flowers, followed by citrus fruit but also white fruit

2019 Pouilly Fumé Baron de L

£210

This dry white displays a classic smokey, lime and mineral influenced flavour reflective of the region's flinty soils. Delivering an elegant and well balanced taste of kiwi fruit and gooseberries it then leaps into a fresh and clean tang with a delicious zesty lime finish

Burgundy

2022 Chablis, Dom. Alain Gautheron

£72

100% Chardonnay. The nose is intense with peach, pear and citrus aromas balanced with a very distinct minerality. The palate is rich and intense with a very nice mineral balance.

2020 Pouilly Fuissé Pentacrine, Domaine Saumaize Michelin

£92

100% Chardonnay. Succulent, ripe nose of creamy vanilla and pineapples. Rounded and generous palate, offering ripe grapefruits and lemon rind. A judicious use of oak brings depth, texture and nutty characters.

2021 Chablis 1er Cru, 'Mont de Milieu' Dom. Alain Gautheron

£105

100% Chardonnay. It has powerful floral aromas and notes of peaches, apricots and white flower. The palate continues to be expressive with delightful flavours and yet is crisp and dry, with an elegant minerality.

2020 Puligny Montrachet 1er Cru, Les Folatières

£195

100% Chardonnay. Elegant and generous with apricot and mineral notes on the nose and palate.

2020 Chassagne Montrachet 1er Cru, "La Romanée" Dom. Morey Coffinet

£205

100% Chardonnay, complex aromas of fresh white flowers and quince mix with hazelnut and almonds.

2020 Meursault 1er Cru Poruzots,

100% Chardonnay. Beautiful integration of oak with rich, elegantly styled fruit and a balanced acidity through to a wonderful long, butterscotch well sustained finish.

100% Nebbiolo. The particular winemaking style makes it drinkable relatively young. The result is a full-bodied and well-structured wine, rich, full and mellow.

2019 Barolo DOCG "Bisù" Bonfante & Chiarle

100% Nebbiolo. The particular winemaking style makes it drinkable relatively young. The result is a full-bodied and well-structured wine, rich, full and mellow.

2019 Barolo Dagromis, Gaja

£175

100% Nebbiolo, rich and dense in palate, nuanced with liquorice and herb notes.

2017 Sori San Lorenzo, Gaja

£665

100% Nebbiolo. Deep red in colour, with aromas of currant and black cherry and a hint of coffee, with a long, lingering finish and refined tannins.

2020 Cabernet Sauvignon Garda DOC, S. Cristina

£62

100% Cabernet Sauvignon. Full bodied with a distinctive bouquet. Cherry red color with a full bouquet of red berries, mature fruit and jammy notes.

2019 'Ripassa' Valpolicella Ripasso DOC Superior, Zenato

£66

Corvinal, Croatinal, Oseletal, Rondinella grapes. A velvety red, offering fine tannins. Juicy and well balanced.

2021 Pinot Nero Riserva, St Michael Eppan

£74

Bright red. The slow fermentation in small oak barrels maximizes the features making it diverse, complex, and distinctly fruity with a nice hint of vanilla.

2018 Amarone Della Valpolicella Classico Costasera, Masi

£129

40% Corvina, 30% Corvinone, 30% Rondinella. Intense garnet red in colour. Aromas of ripe blueberries, blackberries and cherries. The palate is rich, full bodied and complex.

2021 Russolo Massarac Merlot

Deep red-purplish in colour. Full and fragrant, the wine has a slightly, herbaceous aroma.

2022 Sangiovese Carparzo

£43

Sangiovese 85%, Merlot 5%, Alicante 5%, Petit Verdot 5%

Bright ruby color with hints of violet. Intense, fruity, bouquet, with ripe blackberries, wild strawberries and spice.

2022 Chianti Classico Villa Le Corti, Principe Corsini

£56

A classic style, with a youthful and fruity intensity. Ruby-red in color, floral notes of violet and iris, fresh ripe cherries, and a mild spicy nuance. Complimented by well balanced acidity, soft tannins and a long persistent finish.

2020 Chianti Classico Riserva, Tenuta Tignanello, Marchese Antinori

£105

Expressive on the nose with fresh notes of red fruit that lead over to floral hints of mallow and lavender. The rich bouquet is accented by sweet notes of white chocolate that give rise to piquant spicy aromas.

2021 Vino Nobile Montepulciano, Boscarelli

£85

70% Sangiovese 30% Canaiolo. Intense aromas of red fruit and sweet spices.

2021 Il Bruciato, Antinori

£87

65% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot, 15% Syrah. Intense aromas of red berries with note of sweet spices well balanced.

2022 Rosso di Montalcino, Camigliano

£70

100% Sangiovese. Pleasantly easy, elegant and fine at the palate, at the nose it shows red berries and pomegranate, violets and a balsamic note of pine tree

2020 Cont'Ugo, Tenuta Guado al Tasso, Antinori

£120

Its nose is compelling, rich in intriguing aromas of Mediterranean herbs, sweet spices and liqueur cherries. Velvety tannins on the palate are well sustained by bright acidity.

2018 Brunello di Montalcino Caparzo

£138

100% Sangiovese. Dark ruby-red. Full, round and silky, with aromas of blackberry and plum. Full bodied elegance with fine tannins.

2017 Brunello di Montalcino, Pieve Santa Restituta, Gaja

£175

100% Sangiovese. Deep ruby color, expressive aroma of wildflowers, ripe cherry, balsamic notes. It's full-bodied with flavors of fresh plum, herbs, well-integrated wood silky tannins.

2010 Brunello di Montalcino, Biondi Santi

100% Sangiovese. Deep ruby red. With cherry notes, forest fruits, aromatic herbs and juniper aromas. On the palate ripe tannins, integrated

The wine has a plum-cassis smoky nose, is full-bodied, rich and complex, with exceptional structure and lengthy finish.

Blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Cabernet Franc & Petit Verdot. Silky-texture with big ripe but dry tannins.	
2020 Solaia, Antinori	£840
75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Sangiovese. The wine is elegant with nicely blended tannins. Hints of liquorice and coffee return in the impressively long finish.	
2018 Sassicaia, Tenuta San Guido	£640
85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Cabernet Franc. Sassicaia is intensely fruity, finely structured and complex. It has spicy tones, almost smoky nose, and intense taste, long and elegant.	
2019 Masseto	£1,900
The youthful colour suggests a rich and intense wine, the nose shows textbook scents of ripe cherries, violet, liquorice and dark chocolate. The palate is broad and dense with velvety and refined tannins that coat the palate, while leaving a fresh and vibrant finish	
2011 Masseto	£2,700
A rich, ripe expression of one of Italy's iconic wines. With aromas of red currants, tobacco, oak and exotic spice while the full-bodied palate delivers dried black cherries, blueberry extract, licorice and black pepper.

100% Montepulciano. Ripe red fruit, violets and spicy notes of liquorice, clove and cocoa. Full bodied with sweet and velvety tannins.

2022 Primitivo di Manduria, D.O.C. 'Villa Santera'	£65
100% Primitivo. Notes of plum, spices, with character and great structure.

Blend of Cannonau, Malvasia Nera, Carignano and Bovale Sardo.

100% Nerello Mascalese. Ruby red in colour, this wine has spicy pepper aromas with notes of blackcurrant and mountain herbs. The texture is vibrant and with soft, supple tannins.

Burgundy - Rhône Valley

2018 Châteauneuf du Pape, Domaine du Grand Tinel £105

60% Grenache, 40% Syrah, after 24 months maturation in oak barrel, the richness and power is softened with complex aromas of wild herbs, cedar, and pepper. It has concentrated flavours of cherry, strawberry and prune held by a strong spicy character with luscious notes of chocolate and mocha on the finish.

2016 Gevrey Chambertin 1er Cru Lavaux St Jacques, Domaine Pierre Naigeon £220

100% Pinot Noir. A wine of great complexity, finesse and power that brings notes of black cherry and blackberry to the fore with delicate mineral undertones. Silky, with supple tannins and wonderful freshness.

Bordeaux

2016 Château Batailley, Grand Cru Classé, Pauillac £165

70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc. This is a solid muscular dense plum colour wine, earthy cassis aromas as well as flavours. Medium to full bodied, tannic and fresh with a crisp profile.

2015 Segla Margaux , Château Rauzan Segla £145

This is the second wine of Château Rauzan-Ségla, an estate that is currently producing some of the best wine of Margaux. Slightly more Merlot and just 15% new oak ensures that the Segla blend is ripe and flattering. An intense and seductive bouquet combines perfumed rose petal, spice and cedar aromas leading to a complex palate rich with flavours of sweet cherry, redcurrant and mineral.

2018 Château Lafon-Rochet, Grand Cru Classé St Estèphe £190

Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot. Medium-bodied palate is filled with herb-laced red and black fruits, framed by chewy tannins and bright acidity, finishing with a lively lift. Firm and minerally with lots of ripe, correct fruit in the middle.

2022 Rose' IGT Salento Five Roses

Malvasia Nera, Negroamaro. Five Roses was first produced in 1943 and was the first Rosato Wine produced in Italy. Crystalline red cherry colour, it enchants with fruity scent of cherry and strawberry. Fresh, crisp acidity, good structure.

2023 Whispering Angel, Château d'Esclans, Côtes de Provence

£64

The blend consists of Grenache, Cinsault, Rolle (Vermentino), Syrah and Tibouren. Petal aromas, soft summer fruit flavours, crisp, clean, fresh and elegant. The grapes come from the most select land in the surrounding region of La Motte in Provence.

2021 Rock Angel, Château d'Esclans, Côtes de Provence

£78

Partially fermented and aged in large oak barrels, complex notes of liquorice and hint of angelica. Full of harmony on the palate with delicious red fruit flavours with a surprising spicy finish.

2020 Château d'Esclans Garrus, Côtes de Provence

£220

Concentrated aromas and flavors of dried citrus peaches and passion fruit give this rosé a powerful nose. A bright acidity with glazed pear and pineapple filling the mid palate. Garrus' toasty notes are reminiscent of a vintage Champagne without the bubbles. A long, vertical texture with a creamy finish that features rich, spicy notes. Powerful and elegant
