2023 Gavi di Gavi, Masseria Dei Carmelitani

Made from the grapes of a single vineyard, this Gavi di Gavi has expressive aromas of floral notes, ripe pear & citrus fruit. The wine is aged on its lees to give soft texture and complexity. The palate has a graceful balance of stone fruit, ripe orange and citrus notes, and a long crisp finish.

2023 Gavi dei Gavi D.O.C.G. La Scolca

100% Cortese. On the nose intense fruity and flowery notes. Almonds and hazelnut on the palate. Medium to full bodied, with a very long and rich finish.

2022 Rossj Bass, Gaja

A Chardonnay blend exuding an elegant profile, this standout vino is synonymous with refined flavours. It greets the senses with rich aromatic notes of apple, peach, and citrusy undertones. On the palate, its creaminess marries harmoniously with balanced acidity, leading to an indulgently long finish.

Brilliant gold in color, Sergio Zenato Riserva Lugana offers an intense yet elegant floral bouquet. Beautifully layered on the palate, this wine tantalizes the senses with notes of stone fruit, vanilla and white flowers.

Intense floral scent and sweet-spice, aromatic richness, & strength. Fine spices, cloves & the gentle fragrance of roses.

2023 Sauvignon Blanc DOC Collio Livon

Its bouquet, intense and characteristic, recalls exotic fruits, melon and yellow peppers. On the palate is dry, with a good structure, generous.

2022 Pinot Bianco, Jermann £84 It has a golden, brilliant straw-yellow colour. Its aroma is intense, very persistent and pleasantly fruity with a distinct hint of melon. Its taste is dry, velvety, well-orchestrated and very persistent. 2023 Pinot Grigio Friuli Grave D.O.C Lamis Forchir £49 The color is light and bright straw yellow, quite consistent. First of all, the unmistakable olfactory imprint of lychee, then grapefruit, pineapple and pear is striking; there are very delicate floral and herbaceous sensations (elderberry, hay). Dry, fresh, mineral. Umbria £190 2022 Cervaro Della Sala. Antinori 90% Chardonnay, 10% Grechetto. Fresh bouquet of hazelnut butter, vanilla and white flowers. It is elegant on the palate and extremely savoury, crisp, and vibrant. Tuscany 2022 Vernaccia di San Gimignano, Vigna Santa Margherita, Panizzi £69 A broad and inviting nose of white fruits, peach and apricot, alongside nettles and white flowers. The palate is round and rich with sweet yellow fruit, melon, tertiary notes, crushed flint stone, and subtle oak influence. £70 2021 Casadei Le Anfore Ansonaco 100% Ansonica. The wine has seen skin contact for 100 days and is vinified and aged in terracotta amphorae for 4 to 6 months. Typical of the orange style, the palate has some light phenolic structure as well as notes of white peach and plum. The tannins are supported by excellent freshness and acidity which combined with a persistent herbal character leaves an impressive finish. Campania 2022 Greco di Tufo, D.O.C.G Lapilli £61 Notes of stone fruits dominate the aromas with peach and apricot, with hints of pear, almond, sage and a twist of minerality. The acidity cleanses the palate and keeps the wine refreshing and moreish, while the ripe fruit gives the wine a certain roundness and softness which balances perfectly. Sicily 2022 Alta Mora, Etna Bianco £58 100% Carricante. Bright yellow with deep aromas of ripe apple, white flowers, lemon icing and ginger. Spicy and rich, finishes long with nuances of minty herbs at the back. Sardegna 2023 Vermentino di Sardegna Manzanille, Gabbas £55 100% Vermentino. An elegant nose; floral, citrus notes and almond.

Smooth and well-rounded with zesty acidity and lovely minerality.

A nice long finish with a lingering taste of almond.
